## Key vocabulary

**Continent**—any of the world's main continuous expanses of land (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica).

**The outback**—the remote and usually uninhabited inland districts of Australia.

**The equator** - a line notionally drawn on the earth equidistant from the poles, dividing the earth into northern and southern hemispheres.

**Indigenous** – originating or occurring naturally in a particular place; native.

**Extinct** – (of a species, family, or other larger group) having no living members.
