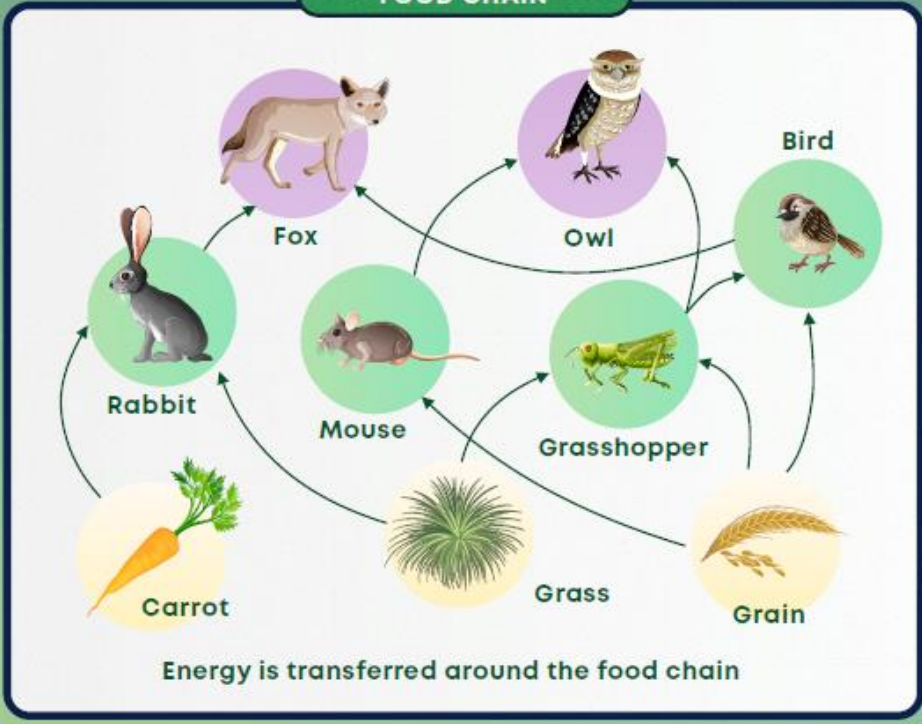




KEY VOCABULARY

Alive	A plant or animal that is alive <b>moves, grows and reproduces</b>
Dead	Something that was a living thing but is <b>no longer alive</b>
Habitat	A <b>place</b> where plants or animals live
Microhabitat	A <b>very small part of a bigger habitat</b> , e.g. woodlice living under stones in a garden
Adaptation	Many plants and animals have adapted so they can <b>survive in a particular habitat</b>
Food chain	A food chain is a diagram which shows us <b>how animals are linked by what they eat, and what eats them</b> . Energy and nutrients are transferred around the food chain
Producer	Plants are called producers because they <b>produce their own food</b> . Food chains start with a producer (plant), nutrients and energy are transferred to the consumer
Consumer	A consumer is a plant/animal that <b>eats another plant or animal</b>
