
World Book Day - CHANGE of PATE - 6th March


A little further ahead, World Book Day is on the 7th March but we will be celebrating it on **6th March** next year and we the theme for dressing up, is animal book characters.

Attendance

The Government are concerned about the non-attendance of children in schools. Below is a table that explains when they become concerned. When a child's attendance is 90% or below, this is a concern and their attendance is monitored closely on a weekly basis. Children below 90% are known to have 'persistent absence'. Each case is looked at on an individual basis, but at Emneth Academy if we believe there is a concern you may be invited in for an intervention meeting, to see if there is anything we can help with to increase your child's attendance.
