Message from the Principal:

Dear Parents,

I have been super impressed by the behaviour and 'growth' in attitude we have seen in our children this year, particularly in our Year 6 group. Engagement, excitement and good manners have been commented upon in recent visits and from visitors to our school. Emneth Academy is truly a unique and wonderful place for children to grow and learn. We are further developing our provision to be able to improve our offer for pupils with additional needs, particularly in speech and communication, which also enables classwork to be appropriately tailored – more on this later.

Congratulations to all Year 6 pupils for completing their SATS with confidence and determination. Results are due in early July – these will come out with the Annual Pupil Report unless we hear otherwise. We will keep you informed.

Annual pupil reports are due to be sent out to you on 10th July.

As we approach the final half term of the year, I would like to send out a few reminders:

- Please do send your child to school with a cap or sunhat – it is likely to be warm and sunny
- Please ensure your child has sun cream on in the mornings, before they come to school. They may bring a small, named bottle/tube of sun cream to top up later, but they must be able to do this independently. We can supervise, but not apply it.
- Remember that during the warmer weather, children do need to drink more – we encourage this, so please remind children that they need to drink.
- We are completing assessments for all children, including writing for Year 6, so prompt attendance is really important. Please do let us know if you have any issues getting to school on time.
- Please see the dates list for exciting sports and arts activities.

We have had a busy half term, but the next one is always busier! After the half term break, we will be covering RSE (Relationships and sex education). It is really helpful if you can talk to your children, about how to resolve issues calmly, taking a minute to think and being kind to each other. Many fall-outs on the playground happen because children have not taken time to think about what happened. We will be encouraging them to talk, to solve problems; we know that change can be unsettling and they are all beginning to think of their new classes. Through impending change, kindness is our super-power!
